

ICAEP ACTIVITIES IMPLEMENTATED

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Within the project "Improving Competences of Adult Education Professionals " our Staff participated in three training courses. The trainings courses were identified according to the key competences that adult education staff should possess to meet the needs of adult learners.

The first structured training course "DIGITAL SOCIAL INNOVATION AND SOCIETAL CHANGES" was provided by ~~Eco~~stituto del Friuli Venezia Giulia – Italy from 17.08.2020-21.08.2020. This training included hands-on tasks, presentations, workshops and activities for self-reflection. The training course covered a variety of theoretical and practical issues related to Digital Social Innovation issues, collaborative digital teaching/learning tools, Illustrating and discussing the report by Deloitte Global and GBC-Education; Adult learning methodologies, Tips for designing an online adult learning training course

The second structured training course "EU POLICY FRAMEWORKS AND PRACTICES IN ADULT EDUCATION" was provided by Demir consulting & project - Brussels from 12.07.2021 to 16.07.2021. It was a training given to deepen the understanding of adult education and training policies in Europe, to share experiences and good practices among participants and to increase the knowledge of adult education professionals about the European Union. There were discussions and working groups within the scope of the training. The participants had the opportunity to meet with the representatives of adult education institutions to discuss the latest developments in this field. During the five-day training, the participants had the opportunity to learn about adult education, which is managed by experienced staff of Demir Consulting. It was possible to participate in sessions with the participation of representatives of adult education institutions and representatives of non-governmental organizations in Brussels. Following all sessions, participants participated in practical workshops, which have the opportunity to put into practice the ideas discussed and to associate them with their work at national, regional or local level. This training was also a starting point for adult education professionals, offering them the opportunity to establish new contacts and partnerships.

The third structured training course DIGITAL TOOLS & INFORMATION COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY TECHNIQUES TO CREATE INCLUSIVE LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS was provided by ITC International-Prague from 13.08.2021-29.08.2021. The training targeted at building and elaborating the digital skills of adult education staff, who is working with disadvantaged groups such as immigrants, early school leavers, unemployed, adults with special needs, adults with literacy and low basic skills, and adult learners at risk of exclusive. The participants were given handout/manual with guidance and training in using ICT tools and digital methods to provide basic skills training to adults. The training aimed at developing the skills, which are demanded by the adult education sector and to strengthen the competences of trainers by sharing knowledge, experiences and good practices. The participants obtained supplementary materials and teaching activities through online tutorials and seminars.
