methods used to evaluate and/or assess learning outcomes

**Please describe, for each activity, the methods used to evaluate and/or assess learning outcomes (e.g. through reflections, meetings, monitoring of learning outcomes, testing)?**

Three structured course activities were carried out within the scope of our project.

The knowledge, skills and attitudes obtained from the structured courses activity were evaluated using the following methods.

- Surveys and researches: Surveys and researches conducted before and after training according to the type of impact
- Observation: Evaluating attitude changes in students and staff by observing
- Statistics: Evaluation according to website and social media account data such as blogs created (number of posts, number of blog readers)
- Ability tests: Skill assessment done before and after mobility, evaluation according to test results
- Document analysis to evaluate the European aspects of products
- Language portfolio
- Group discussion about mobility experience
- Mobility Tool Self-Assessment Questionnaires
- Group discussion about the mobility experience: brainstorming, world cafe, storytelling

Moreover the evaluation was done in two lines:

The sending institution - evaluated the mobility as a whole to see whether it has reached its objectives and desired results.

The sending and host institution: monitored and evaluated the progress of the mobility on an on-going basis and took appropriate action if was required
